

# iPad Printing

## The PaperCut iPad App (Mobile Client)

The PaperCut App for iPad (also known as the [Mobile Client](#)) is required for printing to NDA managed printers. The App authenticates each print job - effectively linking up users with their print jobs. It can also provide balance display, print job confirmation, shared account selection and message notification.

Download the app here: <http://stada:9191/ios/install>. \*\*\*\*you cannot get the app from the app store.

After accessing the installation URL on an iPad / iPhone (iOS device) an **Install Profile** dialog should appear. Follow the prompts to install the App. Afterwards; a **Printing** App (actually a Web Clip) should be available on the home screen.

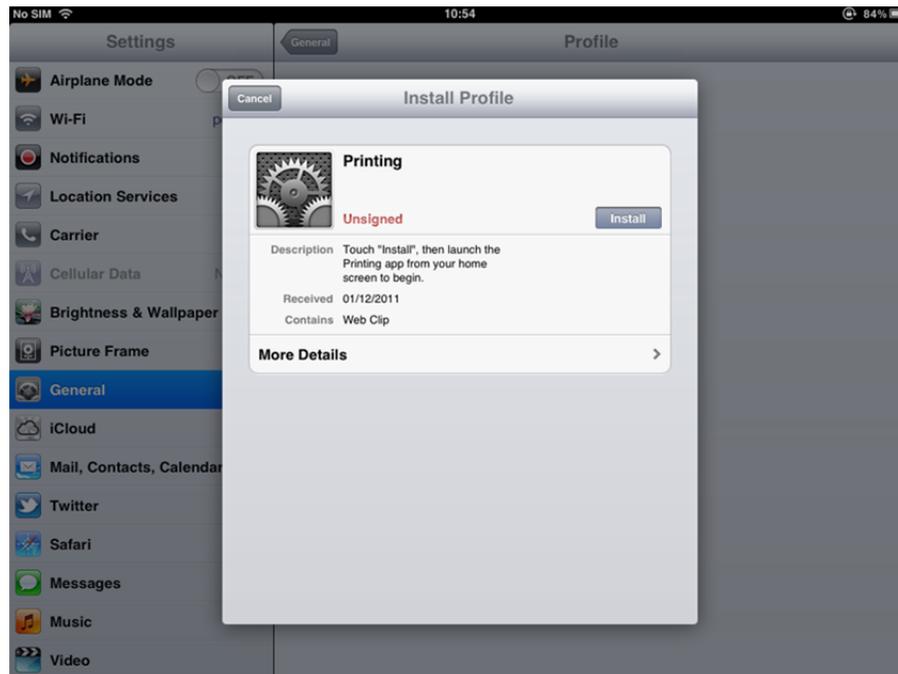


Figure 23.9. The "Install Profile" dialog, displayed after accessing the installation URL

## Usage

The PaperCut App for iPad / iPhone ([Mobile Client](#)) is used to:

- Authenticate the user and their print jobs.
- Display the user's balance.
- Perform print job confirmation.
- Display [Print Scripting](#) messages.
- Perform other functionality such as message notification.

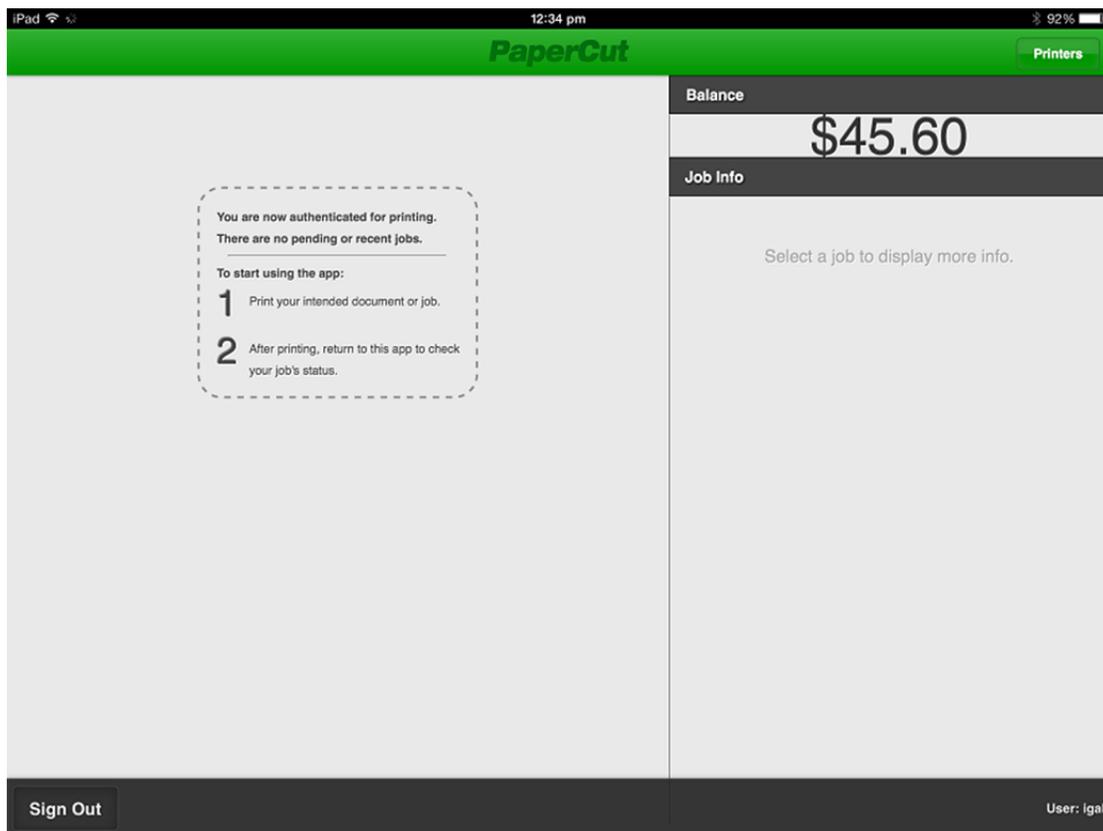


Figure 23.11. The PaperCut App for iPad (before printing)

## Scenario: Student Printing

1. The student prints from their selected app. Choose the printer that best meets your needs.

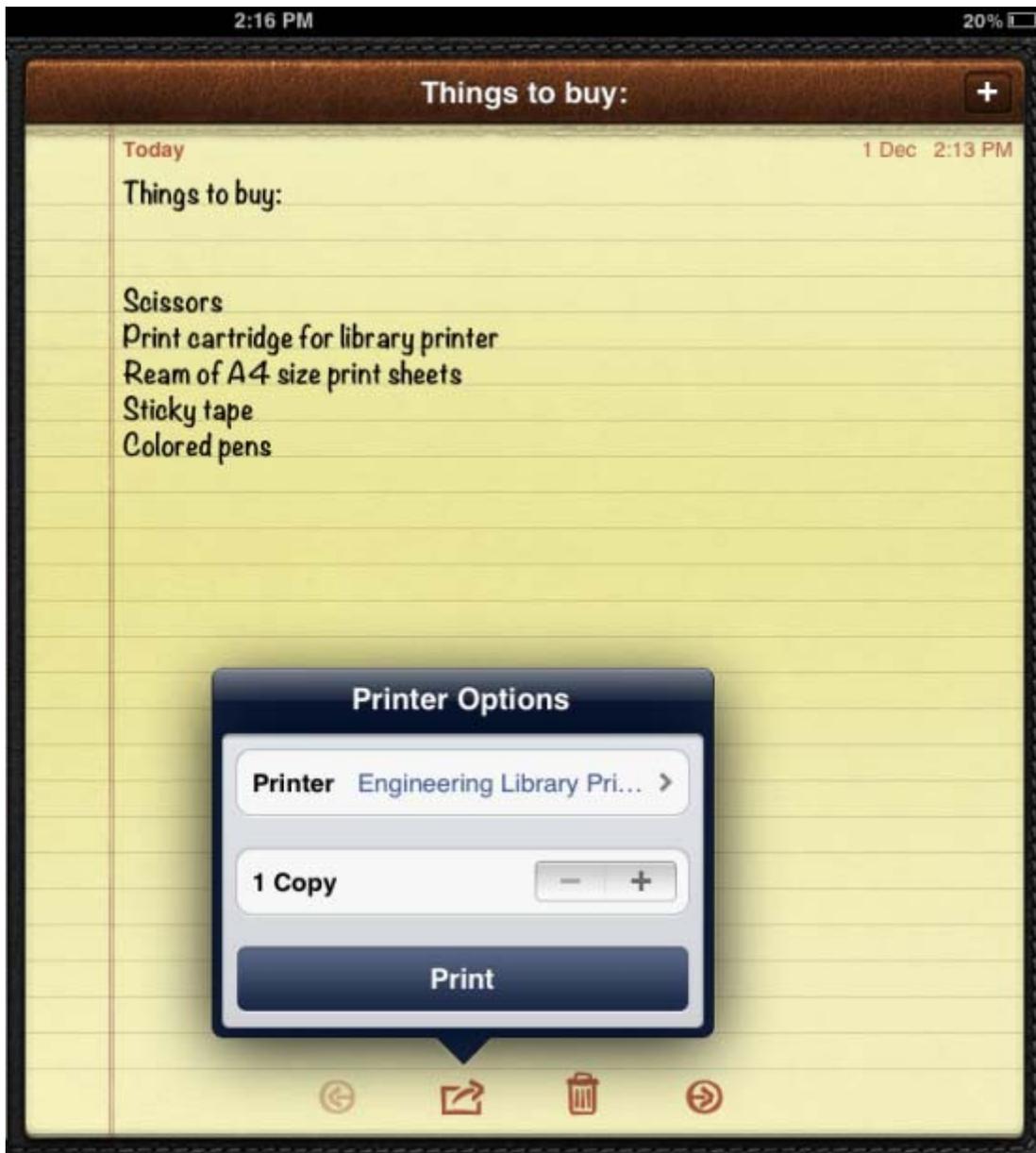


Figure 23.13. Printing from iOS

- The student closes the app and opens the Printing (PaperCut) app.

- The student enters their username and password. On a personal device this step only needs to be performed once. Future logins are performed automatically through the use of an authentication cookie.

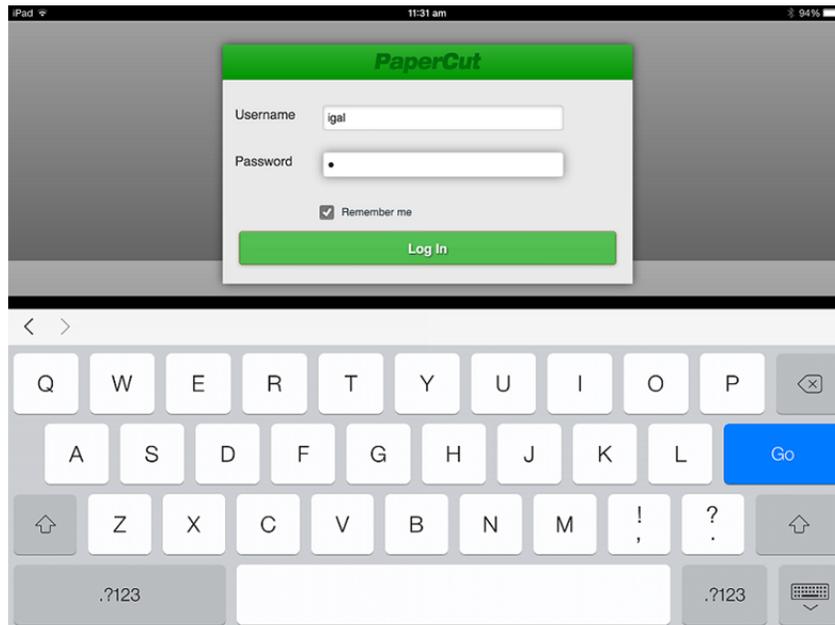


Figure 23.15. Authenticating to the PaperCut iPad App

4. The student's print job is authenticated and proceeds to print. The student can see their job's progress in the app.

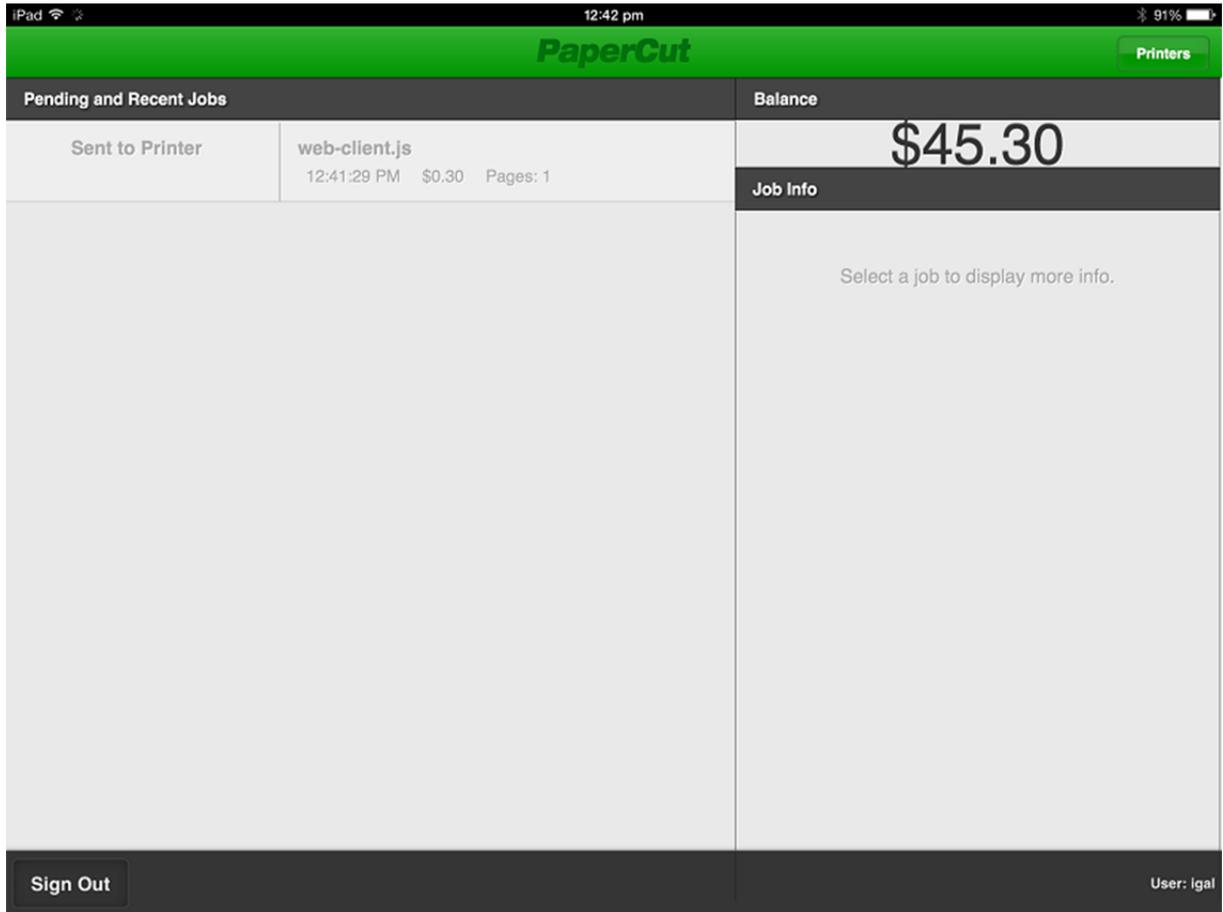


Figure 23.16. The PaperCut App for iPad (after printing)
